Opportunities

YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID TRAINING (YMFA)

- Initial Grant: School-Based Mental Health Grant
 23 school divisions currently participating in the through RHRN, with three slots available per school.
- Additional Opportunities: 16 additional school divisions have committed to YMFA "Train the Trainer" opportunity as of today.
- A total of 80 training slots will be available
- If all training slots are filled, each of those trained have the ability to go back to their school divisions and train up to 30 staff for each session
 - The potential is 2,400 (80 x 30 = 2,400) school staff statewide trained in the fall
 - If that trainer conducts two trainings (once each in fall/spring), that number doubles
